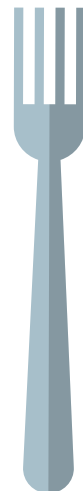


PIZZ-A-THON COMPETITION



Pizz-A-Thon is a state wide program dedicated to teaching 4th grade students about agriculture and where their food comes from. Linn, Delaware and Buchanan County Farm Bureau partnered with Pizz-A-Thon to offer a unique, up-close agriculture experience to fourth grade classrooms in your county. Pizz-A-Thon will be offered virtually this year. Students will work in groups to research and develop a presentation about where their pizza ingredients come from. Classrooms will be provided a kit that includes materials about pork, dairy, beef, vegetables, and wheat. The program will include support for teachers, books & resources, and a short video. By incorporating agriculture into students curriculum we create a more educated workforce, some of which will go into the food industry and continue to feed America into the future.

A Pizz-A-Thon Competition will be held on the last day. Students will present to the class.
